2008 - 2009 "CO-HABIT" BAR CODE/DECAL REQUEST PROPERTY OWNERS ONLY

LOWA Regulations V.A. USE OF INDIVIDUALLY OWNED PROPERTY reads as follows:

"Each dwelling unit within the Subdivision shall provide a residence for only one household, i.e., one person or two persons and their immediate families (father, mother, grandmother, grandfather, sisters, brothers, children, grandchildren, and persons married to same) living together as a single housekeeping unit or not more than two persons living together as a single housekeeping unit though not related by blood, adoption or marriage. Excluded are aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and cousins."

I certify that _____ and I cohabit together as a "single housekeeping unit though not related by blood, adoption or marriage." Therefore, I request that he/she be authorized a LOWA bar code for his/her vehicle. It will be my responsibility to remove the vehicle bar code/decal and notify the Administration Office by completing a bar code deactivation form should the above named person and I terminate our living together as a single housekeeping unit. Further, I understand I will be responsible for the actions of the above named person while living in my Lake of the Woods home, to include payment of any fines, charges or damages that he/she may incur.

OR

Upon LOWA approval and the return of one of my issued membership cards, I may have said card annotated and reissued with the name of the person stated above. I understand that this annotated card may then be used to obtain a vehicle bar code/decal and amenity services by said person, upon payment of applicable amenity fees. Should the living arrangement be terminated the annotated card must be returned to the administration office and deactivation of appropriate bar codes/decals must be requested.
